**Warning:** Sampling results indicate bacterial levels exceed one or more state health standards at this location. Yellow 'WARNING' signs have been posted at the beach. The County Health Officer cautions that contact with ocean water may increase risk of illness. Swimmers are advised to stay out of the water a minimum of 50 yards away from both sides of creek mouths or storm drains.
